Mr. Davids has published four books on coffee, including his latest: 21st Century Coffee: A Guide. He has traveled throughout the coffee growing world and has given hundreds of presentations and trainings to coffee professionals and aficionados. Throughout the year, we publish hundreds of additional reviews that are not associated with a tasting report.



In 2024, Coffee Review readers will drink more than 1.5 billion cups of coffee.


Worldwide "Distribution"



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
Online Advertising Placements

Advertising Types

Ad banner types positions are available as described below and displayed in the image on the previous page.

Shared Side Banner #1 and #2

Our most popular and affordable banner advertising options, we offer two sizes of shared side box banners that rotate a new ad banner every eight seconds. These ad positions are available on a monthly basis. Side Box #1 is 300x190 pixels and provides an estimated 60,000 banner impressions per month. Side Box #2 is 300x250 pixels and delivers an estimated 75,000 impressions per month.

Dedicated Side Banner #3, #4, and #5

Do you want a larger ad that displays to 100% of Coffee Review visitors? If so, a dedicated side box banner ad is the perfect option. These three ad banner positions are available on a weekly basis. All dedicated side box banners deliver an estimated 40,000 impressions per week. Side Box #3, #4, and #5 are 300x250 pixels. Dedicated side box banners are popular because they deliver impressions more quickly than shared positions and click-through rates are typically higher than shared positions.

Top Button
